SSRS

- Introduced with SQL Server 2000
- Conventional paginated reports
- Major update in v2016

Overview of Power BI and SSRS

Power BI

- Separate from the SQL Server BI stack
- Develop locally in Power BI Desktop
- Deploy to cloud service for sharing

Overview of Power BI and SSRS

Power BI and SSRS integration

- Much in common, but...
- Very little integration between the products

Power BI Report Server

Power BI Report Server

- Brings together a common platform for both SSRS reports and Power BI reports
- Allows deployment of Power BI reports to an on-prem server

Power BI Report Server

- Separate install from SQL Server
- Includes all the functionality of SSRS
- No gateway required for Power BI reports that use on-prem data sources

Power BI Report Server

- Licensing
 - Requires SQL Server EE with SA, or
 - Power BI Premium
